The online reviews are good and I feel its a good product but since I cant use it I its difficult to accurately rate ease of use.Plenty of length to the cable and easy to turn in tight spaces.It did not work for me. Disappointed.Heres what he had to say This is the first drain snake Ive owned. Got it to have on hand, just in case. The test run went okay. Unlock the thumb screw, manually pull the cable out of the handle. If you go too far, there isnt a stop on the cable, so it will pull out of the handle. Tighten the thumb screw back down. Inset the snake into the drain until you get to the clog and rotate the handle, which rotates the cable. Have paper towels handy. When you retract the cable back into the handle manually there will be some yuck on the cable. You dont want to push that all into the handle. 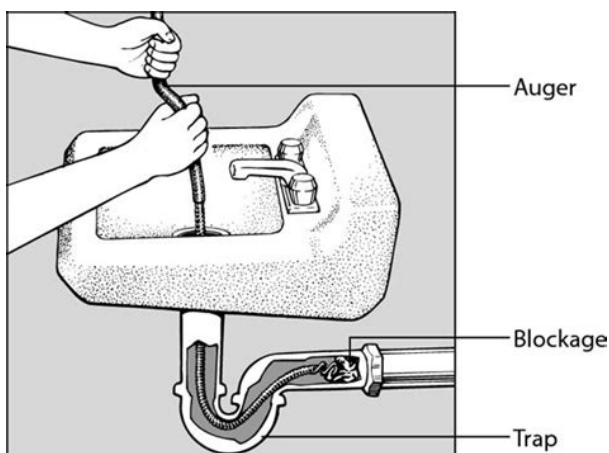

By Michelle Ullman Photo istockphoto.com Potato peels down the kitchen sink. Loose hair swirling through the tub drain. The little plastic soldier your toddler "gave a bath" in the toilet. Clogs happen. When water isn't draining as quickly as it should—or, worse, isn't draining at all—you can reach for a drain snake. Also called a plumbing snake or drain auger, this handy tool is simply a long, thick, flexible wire that "snakes" into drains and pipes to chew through clogs quickly and efficiently. But these blockage busters come in different types and sizes, depending on the recommended use.

If you live in a multistory home with bathrooms upstairs, look for a snake with a 50foot cable capable of reaching clogs in longer pipes. For a more serious clog in your home's main water pipes, blockages further down the kitchen sink drain than your typical food clog, or problems with washing machine drainage, a tougher drain snake designed to handle larger pipes with bigger clogs may be called for. **Drain Snake Head Design** There are two basic types of heads at the tip of a drain snake's cable cutting heads and coil heads. Some drain snakes allow you to switch out the heads, but most have one fixed head. Advertisement Cutting heads have somewhat sharp blades or barbs to chew through solid clogs such as chunks of food or grease, roots, larger pieces of soap, thick clots of leaves or mud, or any other type of fairly solid substance blocking a pipe. These heads are most often found on large, powerful drain augers used by professionals. Coil or toothed heads are the best drain snake choices for most problems encountered by the average homeowner. These heads have a coil of thick wire or a toothed head that latches onto obstructions so they can be pulled back out of the drain.

balledup hair from a tub drain, tackling wads of paper or a flushed diaper, or scraping out fruit peels or other food clogs that aren't solid. Manual vs. Electric Drain Snakes Most drain snakes have a small crank that's turned by hand to advance and retract the cable. These manual drain snakes are good for occasional use around the house to unclog simple blockages in your kitchen or bathroom sink, tub, or toilet. If you expect to use your drain snake on a regular basis perhaps you live in an older home with temperamental plumbing, or have family members unsure of what should not be put down the drain, or if you need to tackle major clogs in gutter downspouts or washing machines, you might prefer the extra muscle and reduced hand strain of an electric drain snake. These tools advance and retract the cable at the push of a button and power their way through stubborn clogs. Drain snakes which can also be referred to as plumbers snakes or augers are typically a step up from a plunger, that are still less expensive than calling a professional plumber to service your home. When researching the best drain snake for home use, its important to consider how deep the obstruction is that youre hoping to clear, how big the drain is, and how much youre willing to spend on a DIY solution. The average drain snake that youll find for sale online or at a hardware store is designed to handle shallow residential shower and sink blockages, but if you are dealing with a stopped up toilet or an extradeep clog, you may want to consider a more specialized or longer drain snake. Keep in mind that using a snake drain can take some practice to master, but the financial savings over time can make it worth the effort to learn how to operate one. As you grip onto the silicone handle and give the tool a few twists, the burrs on the snakes steel spring cable latch onto the wads of hair and other material that may be blocking the pipe. You can then easily pull up the clog, dislodge it from the snake, and dispose of it. I cleaned it a few times with the little plastic zip things which got a lot of stuff out.drain would work a bit better for a few days but then bad again. I included a photo of what came out on the first pull. Drain is, well, actually DRAINING now. Imagine that! And this took less than 5 mins of my time. That way, you dont have to choose between having a functional toilet and a pristinelooking one.

Like other drain snakes, you operate it by manually feeding the snake down into the pipe and then twirling the handle in a circular motion. The snake then grabs the clogged material, allowing you to pull it up and out the pipe. Had used two different plungers, which would get water flowing but the smallest bit of toilet paper being flushed would slow it to a near stop again. Used dish soap and warm water from a large pot, didnt fix the toilet. Used a flexible drain snake but it was unable to dislodge whatever was stuck in the bend. It has over 50 feet in length and is made of extra durable and rustproof steel wire, ensuring that it can not only reach but pull up debris buried deep inside a long pipe. So whether you need to clear a basement floor drain or a backyard pipe, this heavyduty drain snake is up to the task. Best suited for 1.25 to 2inch width drains, this snake has over 25 feet of cable and works to break up and push debris through a pipe rather than trying to pull it up to the surface. To use it, you feed the cable into the drain, and when you reach the blockage, secure the cable place with the thumbscrew. You can then either manually turn the handcrank or use the drill adaptor to rotate the cable inside the pipe. Either way, this drilling action will effectively clean the pipe, loosening any clogged material and allowing it to wash away the next time you run water through the pipe. I tried all kinds of liquid drain cleaners, including the one that comes with the long, plastic strip that is supposed to fish out hair and clogs nothing worked. 10 minutes of working with this tool, though, and now my tub drains just as well as if it were brand new. Repeat the process if the drain is slow or the toilet backs up again.

Helpful Hint Clean your drain snake outside with water and a wire brush. You can then lay your drain snake out on newspaper to completely dry before you put it away. Doing this will ensure a longlife for your plumbers snake and a tool thats clean the next time you need to use it. clearing a blockedup pipe. Usually, this comes in the form of a plastic forked apparatus that is inserted into the drain and turned until the clog is broken up or freed. Electric Electric augers often work similarly to manual augers in so far as they work to break up and remove clogs through a toolbased medium. However, rather than functioning on the users power, electric models use an engine or battery to electronically drive the process, increasing torque and reducing effort overall. Mechanical These augers tend to bridge the gap between manual and electronic augers with regards to function. While these methods require the manual operation of its user, they can simplify the effort needed to remove a pipe clog by adding some type of mechanized component. Often, these components increase torque and allow for a more effective clog removal than a manual apparatus alone could accomplish.

Sizes **Top snake** These small handheld plumbing snakes are compact and best suited to removing clogs in household drains. Often, these mechanical augers can be used on sink drains in both the bathroom and kitchen, with a functional length up to 25 feet in many cases. **Toilet Auger** These simple mechanical augers are unique in their form factor and function such that they can slip down a toilet's main piping without damaging the porcelain surface or protective coating. These are designed to be used when a manual plunger will not suffice. **Medium Snake** When a top snake does not suffice to clear a clog, a medium snake acts as the next step up in both size and function. These models tend to be electronic and make use of a motor to provide both torque and pressure. Professional plumbers most often use medium snakes when they are called to onsite jobs. **Large or Heavy Snake** These snakes are the absolute top end of the plumbing snake spectrum in terms of size and function. Though these heavy snakes can clear virtually any impaction, they are also the most expensive by far. These models are generally only used by plumbers who expect to work in industrial settings for an extended period. **What to Consider When Buying A Plumbing Drain Snake** **Power Source** As with any other tool in your collection, you should give special consideration towards the power source based upon how much and what type of effort you want to put into this specific job. Handpowered plumbing snakes work well for small or straightforward clogs, while electric and batterypowered models provide extra torque beyond what the human hand alone can produce. If portability is a consideration on your shopping list, also consider that both handpowered and batterypowered models do not require a direct plugin. **Length of Cable** Rather than referring to the length of the power cable, cable length in the context of plumbing snakes refers to how far into a pipe a snaking mechanism can reach. These specialized ends and attachments are generally used to accommodate unique piping

architecture or unique clog construction. Cable Diameter In the context of plumbing snakes, cable diameter refers to the size of the snake cord itself rather than the power cord that supplies the device. Choosing the right cable diameter is important because only specific cable sizes will fit into small pipes, while a small cable diameter may not supply enough torque in an extralarge pipe. Warranty As with many types of tools, an applicable warranty can be the difference between swift return and a hairpulling customer service experience.
